

available stock on hand or from expected litters. **The Puppy** shall have an identification micro-chip implanted prior to leaving **The Breeder's** care, custody and control.

The Breeder will register **The Puppy** with the American Kennel Club as either Full Registration (with breeding rights) or Limited Registration (without breeding rights). Breeding rights are not conveyed to **The Buyer** unless **The Puppy** is Fully Registered with the American Kennel Club. **The Buyer** agrees to execute the documents required for registration purposes and return them to **The Breeder** with a check or money order payable to The American Kennel Club in the amount appropriate to cover the Registration Fees. **The Buyer** agrees to return the executed documents to **The Breeder**, along with the Registration Fees before taking delivery of **The Puppy**. **The Breeder** has 12 months after receipt of the executed Registration Form to furnish AKC Registration papers for Full Registration. **The Puppy** is sold primarily as a companion pet; Spaying/neutering is required for the health and welfare of **The Puppy** unless full registration with the AKC is elected under the terms of this contract. **The Buyer** must furnish proof from a certified veterinarian that **The Puppy** has been spayed/neutered prior to **The Puppy** reaching 7 months of age before **The Breeder** will file Limited Registration application with the AKC. If **The Buyer** does not furnish said proof all guarantees mentioned in this contract will be void and NO paperwork will be filed with the AKC. **The Buyer** agrees to allow **The Breeder** to add their kennel signature name ("Proud") as a suffix to puppies AKC Registration Application. The Breeder can not guarantee size, show quality or breeding ability of this puppy. **The Breeder** assumes no responsibility for this puppy after leaving the premises regarding medical expenses or otherwise incurred by **The Buyer** on behalf of this canine without written approval from **The Breeder**. The liability of **The Breeder** shall be limited to the actual purchase price of **The Puppy** under all conditions.

Deposits are not refundable.

Health Guarantee

The Puppy is guaranteed to be healthy at the time of purchase and **The Breeder** will provide a health certificate issued by **The Breeder's** veterinarian. **The Puppy** will be current on vaccinations and deworming at time of purchase. It is the responsibility of **The Buyer** to continue vaccinations and dewormings after time of purchase. It is recommend every two weeks until 18 weeks of age then once annually.

Genetic Guarantee:

The Puppy is guaranteed against any life-threatening genetic problems for one year from the time of purchase or date of delivery, whichever is later. If a life-threatening genetic problem is found, **The Breeder** will replace **The Puppy** with a healthy puppy of similar kind if available. If a replacement is not available within 6 months, **The Breeder** will make a full refund of the purchase price.

Health Guarantee:

The Buyer must take **The Puppy** to a veterinarian at the time when the next puppy shots are due. It needs shots every 3-4 weeks until it is 4 months old. While at the vet **The Buyer** should make sure to have the Vet give **The Puppy** a full examination each time.

- If **The Puppy** is found unhealthy with a non-treatable, life threatening illness, an exchange of another puppy of equal or slightly lesser value will be granted when available, only if **The Breeder** has been contacted within 48 hours of diagnosis of the illness. (No cash refunds will be given.) Ear mites, internal parasites and fungal infections are not serious health problems if treated and are not covered by this warranty.
- **The Breeder** only pay the following prices for common genetic medical problems. It is up to **The Buyer** to find a reasonably priced vet to do the work for the following prices:
 - Umbilical hernias \$50.00
 - Ingonial hernias \$200.00
 - Neuter because of a retained testicle \$100.00 (given only after **The Puppy** is 10 months old)

Claims:

Any claim under either the Health or Genetic Warranties must be accompanied by a notarized letter from a certified veterinarian stating the problem found. **The Breeder** has the right to a second opinion from a veterinarian of its choice.

It is hereby understood by both **The Buyer** and **The Breeder** of **The Puppy**, that **The Buyer** is responsible for all veterinary costs of every kind and nature after the purchase date, including vaccinations. For all purposes given in these guarantees, **The Breeder** has full say in determining if a refund will be given. No other guarantees are made or implied by **The Breeder** except those stated in this guarantee, and all guarantees are strictly on a replacement basis.
